



**SURFSIDE BEACH TOWN COUNCIL WORKSHOP MINUTES
TUESDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2019 AT 10:00 A.M.
TOWN COUNCIL CHAMBERS**

CALL TO ORDER. Mayor Childs called the regular meeting to order at 10:00 A.m. Mayor Childs, Mayor Pro Tempore Pellegrino, and Councilmembers Dietrich, Ott, and Scoles were in attendance. Councilmembers Johnson and Stevens were absent. A quorum was present. Others present: Town Attorney Crosby; Town Administrator Pieper; Town Clerk Herrmann; Finance Director King, and Police Chief Hofmann.

Mayor Childs opened the floor for discussion of Ordinance #19-0907 to amend Chapter 9 Motor Vehicles and Parking. Throughout a lengthy discussion Town Council **CONCURRED** to the following amendments to be presented at second reading:

- §9-1 through §9-7 No changes to draft
- §9-8 Definitions – vehicle *includes* golf cart; no changes to draft
- §9-9(a) No changes to draft
- §9-9(b) Value parking fee \$1 per hour; add Surfside Drive parallel parking to Value Parking at \$1 per hour
- §9-9(g), add commercial busses shall park in designated right-of-way at Memorial Park
- §9-9(c), (d), (e), (f), (h), and (i)(a) No changes to draft
- §9-9(i)(b) 4th Avenue North leased parking lot is the only location that requires payment by all vehicles (remove the pier lot and 212 Surfside Drive lot)
- §9-9(j) Surfside Drive Parking (1), (2), (3) and (4) No changes to draft
- §9-10, §9-11, §9-12, §9-13, §9-14, §9-15 No changes to draft
- Add “permanently” affixed in §9-8; §9-9(g), (h), (i)(a); (j)(3); §9-10; §9-16(a), (4)(i), (f)
- §9-16(a)(1) Full time residents are to receive free parking decals to be permanently affixed to the vehicle for each vehicle that is registered in town; remove \$5 administrative fee
- §9-16(a)(2) Non-resident property owners get two decals free; to be permanently affixed to the vehicle, and may purchase additional decals at \$50 each; remove \$5 administrative fee
- §9-16(a)(3) No changes
- §9-16(a)(4) Nonresident parking passes keep rate at \$200
- §9-16(5), (6), (7), (8), (b), (c), and (d) No changes to draft
- §9-16(e) Remove pier, and 212 Surfside Drive lots
- §9-16(f), §9-17, §9-18 No changes to draft
