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8 CALL TO ORDER

9 The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM. Councilmembers Blair, Childs and Dodge were 10 present. Adhoc member Mr. Truett was also in attendance. Staff present Clerk Pinnell.

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12 **DISCUSSION**

13 There was some discussion regarding the proposed new width of Surfside Drive and the concerns 14 of traffic flow. There was discussion of traffic coming off of Glenns Bay and 17. Ms. Blair 15 stated that she recalls a plan where the crosswalks were designed to slow down traffic as it entered the downtown district. Entering and exiting with street bumps was discussed. Mr. 16 17 Childs stated that the traffic engineers need to participate in the new plan since they are the ones who nixed the idea of adding center parking. Placing a center island and eliminating the parking 18 19 in the center was discussed. Ms. Dodge brought up the need for crosswalks on Ocean Blvd. 20 SCDOT rules were discussed briefly. Raising asphalt and stamping it was discussed. Ms. Blair stated that raised stamped asphalt being used for safety was discussed in the transportation 21 22 element. Mr. Childs stated that he would like to get an opinion from the traffic engineers on the 23 center parking on Surfside Drive. Ms. Dodge brought up the Highland North Carolina street 24 design. Ms. Blair stated that the original goal for Surfside Drive was to give some extra parking 25 to the merchants in the downtown area. If the angled parking in the center is eliminated in that area perhaps parallel parking could be added in the center. Mr. Childs stated that additional 26 27 parking will be added to the lot across from the Sundown and there is the option of looking into 28 the lot where the mural currently sits; the owner was approached with this option. Mr. Truett 29 stated that he would like to see this lot utilized adding that there is a lot of overflow parking in 30 that area. There was discussion regarding preparing a new conceptual design. Ms. Blair stated 31 that Market Common has parallel parking and it works very well there. Mr. Childs recommended having a meeting with Mark Hoeweler from GSATS, the traffic engineers and 32 33 Steve Strickland from Earthworks to discuss a plan. Mr. Truett stated that he feels that there 34 could be a mix of parallel parking and planting in the center. Mr. Childs stated that the town 35 needs to coordinate the town plan with work that will be done on Glenns Bay. There was some 36 discussion regarding the entrance design depicted with an entrance feature and flags. Mr. Childs 37 stated that to save the subcommittee time Mr. Strickland could meet with the traffic engineers 38 then come up with a concept to present to the subcommittee. There was some additional 39 discussion on future plans for Surfside Drive. Placing sod and benches on the corner where the 40 mural is was discussed. Ms. Blair stated that she would like to see that lot used as a stop and rest 41 area rather than a parking lot. Placing lined parking spots next to that lot was discussed. There 42 was discussion whether the area should be metered. Ms. Dodge stated that she would like to see 43 the area metered adding that she feels that a lot of money will be invested in the area and no 44 money will be coming in and the meters would help. Mr. Truett suggested the town look into 45 what other neighboring areas do adding that if it is metered there will be opposition from the merchants in that area. The idea is to bring more businesses to that area and metering the area 46 47 now may deter new business from coming in. Mr. Truett suggested providing free parking for a 48 while and then once that area builds up then metered parking could be added later. Placing

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49 electrical to add a PA system and having events in the downtown area was discussed. Ms. Blair 50 stated that Conway holds town crawls on Thursday nights until 8:00PM to promote local 51 businesses and the town of Surfside could do something similar as well to promote future 52 businesses in the area. Mr. Truett stated that he feels that once the area is redeveloped then new 53 businesses will move in. Ms. Dodge brought up the local merchants not having an established 54 merchant association and thought that would be beneficial for them to do. The merchants keep 55 asking for help from the town. Mr. Truett stated that the redevelopment of Surfside Drive will 56 be the towns' first step to help the businesses in town. There was some discussion regarding 57 making room in the redevelopment for the fire trucks to be able to make the turn onto Surfside 58 Drive. Mr. Childs stated that he would also like to see the left turn lane going from Surfside 59 Drive onto Business 17 longer. Mr. Childs asked Ms. Pinnell to get a hold of Mr. Strickland 60 regarding these issues discussed. Mr. Childs stated that the plan should be coordinated with the installation of the fiber optics installation as well. Costs of materials was discusses briefly, 61 62 concrete, brick and asphalt. Mr. Truett stated that he feels that the hospitality and atax money 63 will come in fairly good this year. There was some discussion regarding how busy the summer 64 has seemed to be compared to the past couple of years. There was consensus of the subcommittee to try to do the redevelopment of Surfside Drive in conjunction with the 65 66 construction of the park/parking lot across from the Sundown. Mr. Truett stated that the Surfside 67 Rotary is always looking for community projects perhaps they could assist with the area. Ms. 68 Blair stated that there are families always looking for ways to honor or memorialize their loved 69 ones; there is a park in Conway that constructed a fountain and gazebo and there were some kids 70 that dedicated a bench to a fellow student that had passed and it was written up in the paper how 71 wonderful everyone thought that was. Ms. Blair suggested that people be allowed to purchase 72 naming rights for something like palm trees. Dedication plaques were also discussed. Mr. Truett 73 stated that Mr. Shelby Smith brought in a proposal for a palm tree discount. There was a 74 discussion regarding the patio at the Veterans Park memorial bricks that sold out. Adding new 75 patios with memorial bricks and adding plaques at the dog park were discussed. Ms. Pinnell 76 stated there is a Tree City grant that may provide funds for some of the trees on Surfside Drive. 77 There was a discussion regarding the grant for the median which was a 60/40 match. The 78 amount budgeted for beautification was discussed. Mr. Truett stated that once this 79 redevelopment is completed he feels that the town will find many more businesses contributing to town events. It was discussed that once the trees are removed the business owners will begin 80 to fix up their storefronts and once one person does it then the rest will usually follow. 81 82

There was a consensus to have Ms. Pinnell contact the design engineers and traffic engineers to have a preliminary meeting then have Earthworks come up with a design to present to the subcommittee. The only change to the plan would be the median. Mr. Childs stressed that this really needs to get going soon.
