The Family Beach



Sometime after the Revolutionary War, John M. Tillman's 3,200 acre Ark Plantation was established and much of that land is now the town of Surfside Beach. After the Civil War, Tillman's family divided the property and the area became known as Roach's Beach and in the 1920s Floral Beach and then in 1952, Surfside Beach. Officially incorporated in 1964, the beautiful beach town with serene beach vistas bordered by lovely sand dunes had an established moniker as a "the family beach".

Super clean and gorgeous, white soft, sand is what you can expect to find when visiting the beaches in Surfside Beach.

There are dozens of accesses to the beach itself for watersports, fishing and surfing. Many beach access areas also have showers, restrooms, and handicap ramps.

A charming community of a mere two miles long, Surfside Beach is filled with rows of lovely pastel beach houses, modern hotels, condos and trendy restaurants.

The Surfside Pier was built in 1953 and offers magnificent view of the area and is a local favorite for fishing. This Pier is perfect for experiencing romantic sunsets or taking the family for a walk to experience the tremendous panoramic views. Fishing rod rentals and bait is available in the full service pier's bait shop.




Along its two miles of pristine oceanfront, visitors now find beach houses, hotels, condominiums, restaurants, and a popular fishing pier. Pristine, beautiful beaches are cleaned daily and supervised by lifeguards and police. Several beach access points offer showers, restrooms and foot showers, as well as handicap-accessible ramps. This eco-friendly town encourages beach-goers to recycle by collecting cans, bottles and newspapers, and there are also 36 access points to the popular beach-perfect for boating, swimming, fishing and surfing. Surfside Beach is also an Autism-friendly family travel destination.





The Destination

The Destination: Surfside Beach

Where: South Carolina, USA

The small town of Surfside Beach, just south of Myrtle Beach, signed a proclamation in January declaring itself an "autism-friendly travel destination." The designation was awarded with the support of the Champion Autism Network. The goal is to create a place where families with autistic children have a place where they can feel completely accepted.

The town is working to raise awareness with restaurants and other hospitality businesses to be understanding and accepting of families with autistic children. Special events are also being planned to encourage families to visit the area, knowing they won't be the only autistic family on vacation there.

This bold initiative is in addition to nearby Myrtle Beach airport's "Quiet Room" in the baggage claim area. Inside the space, kids can decompress with a caregiver while someone waits for the luggage and collects the rental car. Families leaving through the airport can also make use of the rocking chairs in the hallway between Terminals A and B, a spot from which you can also take in the planes arriving and departing on the runway.


