

## SURFSIDE BEACH TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 20, 2019 AT 10:00 A.M. TOWN COUNCIL CHAMBERS

**1. CALL TO ORDER.** Mayor Childs called the special meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. Mayor Childs, Mayor Pro Tempore Pellegrino, and Councilmembers Dietrich, Johnson, Ott, Scoles, and Stevens were in attendance.
